Streetsmart Hazmat

1-day program, NFPA 472 awareness level

Beneficial for anyone who may be first on scene of an Incident involving Hazardous Materials. It is designed to give a better awareness of what to do in the initial stages, how to recognize the presence of hazardous materials, and who to call for assistance. This program offers the basic knowledge & skills to protect yourself, your responders, as well as the public from the effects of a Hazmat emergency.

In addition, this program includes a short introduction and practical demonstration of emergency decontamination procedures for firefighters who may accidentally come in contact with hazardous materials.

Firefighters are requested to bring their turnout gear for the practical demonstration.

Fire Rescue Company Officer

2-day program NFPA 1021 - relevant topics.

Introducing the present or future officers to the roles, responsibilities, authorities, command, and strategies & tactics required to lead members of their department in all aspects of Fire Department operations. In a logical, easy to follow manor, you will progress from the basic concepts to the application of tactics and situational strategies.

This program will meet the prerequisites for ERT-LF301

Incident Safety Officer

1-day program, NFPA 1521

Provides the Company Officer with the skills needed to function effectively as the Safety Officer at the scene of an incident. This course is incident specific, scene oriented, designed to teach what a safety officer at an incident needs to know, using scenarios to convey instructional points.

Low Slope Rescue

1-day program, NFPA 1006, 1670, 1983

An introduction for emergency responders, who require the skills to securely and safely navigate moderate slopes, during emergency rescue situations.

Strategies & Tactics

1-day program

This program offers the newest recruit up to the Chief Administrator, knowledge of the methods and processes used to control and manage a variety of emergency situations. In a logical, easy to follow manor, you will progress from the basic concepts to the application of tactics and situational strategies.

Rapid Intervention (RIT)

1-day program

This program introduces the concepts of the Rapid Intervention Team to the newest member of the department and enhances the skills of the more experienced. The content includes discussion on why the need for RIT, Legal requirements, Building construction, Firefighter safety, RIT size up, Mayday procedures, How to prepare and respond to a Mayday, RIT equipment, Self rescue and firefighter removal techniques.

Fire Pump Operator

1-day program

This program introduces the student to common pumps in the fire service today. It will guide them through the theory of hydraulics, pumping, drafting and challenge them with practical hands-on situations to gain skill and confidence in operating fire pumps.

Reading Smoke & PPV

1-day program, NFPA 1521

This program is designed for Incident Safety Officers, Tactical Officers and Firefighters to improve the skills needed for evaluating fires. These skills are essential in implementing the correct strategies and tactics for hostile fire events. Students will learn how to read smoke, fire, and predict its progress, and make decisions based on knowledge and skill, as well as effectively communicate observations.

Also included in this program is a segment on Positive Pressure Ventilation procedures to ensure the safety of personnel in removing smoke from a structure.

Live Fire – 101 Introduction to Structural Firefighting

1-day NFPA 1001

This course enhances basic training for firefighters by providing an introductory exposure to live-fire conditions inside a structure. Room and content fire scenarios are used to develop knowledge and skills in applying appropriate fire control methods.

The students will be coached to assess situations, coordinate various fire control tasks, search and rescue techniques and identify/communicate benchmarks that could be applied at typical residential fires.

Live Fire - 201 Advanced Structural Firefighting

1-day NFPA 1001

Building on experience gained in LF-101- Introduction to Structural Firefighting, the firefighter will develop significantly more skill and confidence.

The live-fire scenarios are much more challenging and include elements of: below-grade, second floor, third floor, vertical extension, standpipe, apartment pack, ventilation by laddering, search, rescue, multiple team coordination, and multiple company response.

The students will be coached to assess situations, coordinate various fire control tasks, and identify/communicate benchmarks that could be applied at typical residential and small business fires.

Live Fire – 301 Fire/Rescue Officer

1-day NFPA 1001 & 1021

Interesting, challenging, and relevant, this program is designed to assist experienced or new officers in preparation and development of their knowledge and skills to work as a Fire/Rescue Officer within a fire department command structure.

Custom Live Fire programs – All custom programs start with an assessment of the client, then designed specifically to meet the needs of that client.

Live Fire Special –These Live Fire programs are set in a real time format, so that firefighters have an opportunity to experience a more realistic approach to fire incidents. The firefighters will test their skills, while responding to an assortment of calls such as: smoke showing, smell of gas in a house, alarm bells ringing, structure fires, etc. This type of program allows the firefighter to think outside the box, develop action plans, and gain the confidence to safely mitigate emergencies in their community.
